

WHAT HAPPENS ON YOUR VISIT



Individuals and groups attending Space come with their own families or carers who are responsible for them throughout their visit. However, we have a highly experienced team who are delighted to assist you to gain the maximum possible benefit for your session. Anyone new to Space is advised to watch our video on our web site prior to their visit to find out what our three different rooms offer and how they might be used.

Your session

Upon arrival at the centre you will be greeted by a member of the team who will show you to your sensory room. There they will talk you through the equipment available and discuss your preferences. The rooms can be customised to meet the needs of the user, who then has an hour to enjoy the room in any way that suits them, whether that be playing, exploring, or simply relaxing. It is helpful to have an aim for your session, which our staff will help you achieve.

Our centre is staffed by Groups Facilitators who all have extensive experience of working with those with additional needs, as well as knowledge of our specialist equipment. We are always happy to discuss your needs and to provide advice on how to use our equipment to its maximum advantage. Our team are available throughout your session to assist you in any way we can, from altering the temperature of the rooms, to changing individual stimuli for sensory assessment.

Our Facilities

Our Sir Tom Finney Garden room is available for your use before or after your session. This is a communal social and dining area, shared with other visitors. You can purchase a drink and a small snack, or bring your own packed lunch. There is a kitchen for your use, including a microwave, a toaster and a liquidiser. Alternatively, you can bring in food from outside Restaurants. This room leads out to our gardens, which are also available for your enjoyment. Groups which prefer not to mix with other visitors can use our Terrace Room. This room can also be hired for private groups who do not necessarily want to use our sensory rooms. We are delighted to offer the benefit of two '**Changing Places**' facilities which we keep open for use by anyone, including members of the public who are in need. These facilities include hoisting, an adult sized changing area and shower. This ensures that all of our users remain clean and comfortable during their visit.

There is ample parking for those booking sensory sessions, with a number of bays designated to visitors with additional needs, regardless of whether or not they possess a Blue Badge. However, we do ask that visitors without additional needs park on the Homebase car park or on Egerton Road to ensure that groups with sensory issues can gain access to our car park.
